6. Attach the Energy Star Statement of Energy Design or equivalent analysis which shows the performance rating of the project against the appropriate baseline performance rating and the Final Energy Model or Commissioning Report.
7. Attach all supporting documentation identifying the energy efficiency measures that were implemented, as well as the cost of each measure and the completion date.
8. Attach a statement indicating whether any funding for the acquisition, design or construction of the building or other structure, and associated land, is being provided by a governmental entity in this State. If funding is provided by a governmental entity, include a list of all sources of funding.
9. Attach a statement indicating whether the building or other structure is receiving or is expected to receive any other abatement or exemption pursuant to NRS 361.045 to 361.159, inclusive, or NRS chapter 701A from the taxes imposed on real property by NRS chapter 361.
10. Attach a statement indicating whether the building or other structure, or any part thereof, is or is expected in the future to be exempt from the taxes imposed on real property by NRS chapter 361 pursuant to any provision of law other than NRS 361.045 to 361.159, inclusive, or NRS chapter 701A.
11. Identify any information included in this application, which the applicant considers to be confidential (Sec. 23.4) and provide a citation to the specific statute or other legal authority that makes the identified information, confidential.

**NOTE:**

- 1) A project utilizing an aggregated campus-wide energy score will only be issued one tax abatement encompassing all of the structures used to calculate that energy score. The aggregated campus-wide energy score cannot be used for any other project.
- 2) Only one partial tax abatement may be awarded per parcel. If a building or other structure encompasses more than one parcel, only one partial tax abatement may be awarded for the building or structure.
- 3) If a partial tax abatement has ever been awarded for a parcel or for a building in the past, no partial tax abatement may be awarded for that parcel in the future in accordance with NAC 701A.220(6) as amended under R128-18.
- 4) If the project cannot demonstrate energy efficient measures implemented, the project will not be awarded a tax abatement. All measures that achieve the applicable energy points and overall rating must be implemented after the project has received a project registration number from the GOE.
