## December 5, 2017 FISCAL IMPACT Renewable Energy Partial Abatement of Sales/Use Taxes

## Techren Solar I, LLC AFN 17-1127SPV

In accordance with the provisions NRS 701A of the Nevada Revised Statutes, Techren Solar I LLC has requested a Sales and Use Tax Abatement for their Renewable Energy Project. This project is located in Clark County. Upon approval, this project would be granted a partial abatement of Sales and Use Tax for a period of three years, commencing on date of approval.

The Governor's Office of Energy has provided to the Department of Taxation a complete copy of the Renewable Energy Tax Abatement Application for this project. According to Schedule 6 of this application, Techren Solar I, LLC will purchase a total of \$152,586,993.00 worth of tangible, personal property subject to Sales and/or Use Tax during the first year of the abatement period. At the current Sales or Use Tax rate for Clark County, the full Sales Tax for these purchases would be \$12,588,426.93 less any applicable collection allowance.

According to Schedule 7 of this application form Techren Solar I, LLC will purchase \$276,012.00 worth of tangible, personal property subject to Sales and/or Use Tax during the second year of the abatement period. Schedule 8 shows \$281,532.00 of tangible, personal property subject to Sales/and or Use Tax will be purchased during the third year.

Based on this information, the Department of Taxation projects the following Sales Tax related fiscal impact for the three years of the abatement period.
